TEA MARKET REPORT – Sale 38 held on Tuesday 24th January, 2017

CTC LEAF: 43,292 packages of tea on offer met with a fair demand.

BROKENS: BOPs met with only a fair demand and prices eased by a fair margin often by Tk.5/- to Tk.10/- with quite a lot of withdrawals. Smaller Brokens met with some demand particularly the cleaner varieties but eased in value. There was some withdrawals in this category as well. Plain and poor types met with only some demand but prices were slightly easier. There was again heavy withdrawals.

FANNINGS: Good liquoring Fannings met with a fairly good demand at easier rates and these could be quoted between Tk.175/- and Tk.180/-. Mediums saw a further decline in price with more withdrawals. Plain and poor types met with some interest and were about steady. However, there was fair withdrawals.

CTC DUST: 6,137 packages and 26 package of Old Season Teas on offer met with a fair demand. Good liquoring varieties sold well but were an easier market. Others declined even further and eased by Tk.8/- to Tk.12/following quality. Plainer and end of season teas were neglected without any bids. Blenders lent good support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers..

COMMENTS Market continued on the same trend as last whereby better liquoring teas were selling quite well at lower levels. However, like before, plain and poor types were discriminated against by the buyers met with heavy withdrawals. Loose tea buyers lent some support particularly at the lower end of the market as well as buyers for Pakistan.

Dusts were a lower market
