# Tea Auctioneers since 1948 TEA MARKET REPORT – Sale 33 held on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> December, 2016

CTC LEAF: 48,836 packages of teas on offer met with a fair demand with less withdrawals.

BROKENS: BOPs met with only a fair demand and mostly eased by upto Tk.5/- per kg. The plainer types were mostly withdrawn without bids. Smaller Brokens met with a better enquiry and sold fairly well in line with quality but prices were easier. However, poor, plain teas continued to be neglected and where sold were heavily discounted.

FANNINGS: A small weight of good liquoring Fannings on offer met with a strong demand and were mostly dearer often by Tk.2/- to Tk.3/- and sometimes more. Medium varieties met with a better demand but were generally firm. Plain varieties met with a selective interest but poor types were mostly neglected.

CTC DUST: 6,606 packages of teas on offer met with a slightly improved demand. Good liquoring varieties

were mostly a dearer market following strong competition. Other varieties sold at around last levels easing in line with quality. Plain types were mostly neglected. Blenders lent fairly good support with a little more interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS There was a slightly better tone in today's sale owing to good competition for bright liquoring varieties. Blenders were more active along with a little more interest from the Internal buyers. As a result, withdrawals were a little less except the poorest types which continued to be withdrawn.

Good liquoring Dusts were a dearer market

## MOMBASA SALE 50 – 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> DECEMBER, 2016

There was fairly good demand for the 136,864 packages (8,939,011.00kilos) available in the market at irregular levels. 13.51% were however unsold. The best BP1s on offer gained up to USC15 with brighter categories appreciating by USC2 to USC20 while mediums were irregular varying between firm levels to easier by USC10 to USC26 and some lines were unsold; lower mediums were firm to USC10 above previous levels but a few invoices shed up to USC16 with plainer descriptions ranging between firm to USC5 dearer to easier by up to USC10. In the secondary catalogues, BPs eased while PFs were firm. Clean well sorted coloury Fannings and similar DUSTs gained. Other Fannings and similar DUSTs were dearer. BMFs were well absorbed at irregular levels.
