TEA MARKET REPORT – Sale 34 held on Tuesday 27TH December, 2016

CTC LEAF: 53,253 packages of teas on offer met with a slightly better demand.

BROKENS: BOPs met with a fair demand but were slightly easier whilst smaller Brokens met with more demand although prices often shed by Tk.1/- to Tk.2/-Medium types met with fair interest but generally eased further. Plain types continued to meet with a difficult market with heavy withdrawals. Poorer types were virtually neglected.

FANNINGS: Good liquoring Fannings were a strong market and were generally firm to slightly dearer particularly the brighter liquoring varieties. Mediums were a good market and were about steady. Plain varieties met with some interest at lower rates. Poorer types met with limited interest and were mostly withdrawn without bids.

CTC DUST: 6,788 packages of teas on offer met with a fairly good demand. Good liquoring varieties were firm to slightly dearer market following quality. Others also sold well in line with quality but prices were easier. Plainer types were mostly neglected Blenders lent fairly good support with some interest from the Loose tea buyers. .

COMMENTS Blenders were more active for all good liquoring types, Small weight of bright liquoring varieties appreciated following competition. There was fair support from the Internal buyers. Poor and plain teas continued to meet with a difficult market and were mostly withdrawn.

Dusts were a good market.
