**TEA MARKET REPORT - Sale 23 Held on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2017**

CTC LEAF 35,101 packages and 45 packages of Old Season Teas on offer met with a stronger demand at generally higher rates.

BROKENS: BOPs were a strong market and were generally firm to slightly dearer whilst the smaller Brokens continued to meet with a strong competition and were mostly dearer often by Tk.2/- to Tk.4/-. Plain types saw more enquiry and most of it was absorbed at around last levels. There were fewer withdrawals in this category.

FANNINGS: Best varieties continued to attract strong competition and were mostly dearer often by Tk.2/- to Tk.4/-. Mediums were fully firm to often dearer. Plain varieties saw a better demand and were generally steady on last with fewer withdrawals.

CTC DUST: 7,913 packages and 2 packages of Old Season Teas on offer met with a fair demand at easier

rates. Good liquoring teas sold at around last levels with some withdrawals. Others were a lower market and sold at a drop of Tk.3/- to Tk.5/-. Blenders lent active support with some interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: Market started on a firm note which strengthened further with the progress of sale. There was more competition from the Blenders resulting in prices being dearer. There was only some support from the Loose tea buyers.

Dusts were an easier market.
