## TEA MARKET REPORT - Sale 25 Held on Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> October, 2017

CTC LEAF 40,164 packages and 1,539 packages of Old Season Teas on offer met with a stronger demand with prices generally appreciating.

**BROKENS:** All good Brokens were a stronger feature and were generally dearer often by Tk.2/- to Tk.3/-. Medium varieties were also a strong feature and generally sold at dearer levels. Plainer types were often easier with fair withdrawals.

**FANNINGS:** A fair weight of bright liquoring types on offer were strongly competed for and met with a stronger demand and appreciated by upto Tk.5/-. Below best were mostly dearer by Tk.2/- to Tk.3/-. Mediums followed a similar trend. Plainer varieties were often easier with fair withdrawals.

**CTC DUST:** 8,263 packages and 30 packages of Old Season Teas on offer met with quite a good demand. Select few lines of RD and D met with good competition and advanced by Tk.5/ to Tk.7/-. Other

good liquoring teas sold at around last levels. Plainer varieties met with less demand and were easier with a few withdrawals. Blenders lent strong support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

**COMMENTS:** Large offerings met with a stronger demand and were well absorbed at generally higher rates particularly the good liquoring varieties. Blenders operated actively and accounted for most of the teas. There was only some support from the Loose tea buyers.

The bright liquoring types were particularly sought after and appreciated more than others.

Dusts sold well.
