CTC LEAF: 37,498 packages and 190 packages of Old Season & 4 packages of Orthodox teas on offer met with less demand at much easier rates and there were heavy withdrawals.

BROKENS: A few good BOPs met with quite a fair enquiry but prices dropped further often by Tk.6/- to 8/- and sometimes more following quality. There were fair withdrawals in this category. Smaller Brokens met with a fairly good enquiry but at much lower levels often declining by Tk.5/- to Tk.8/-. There were some withdrawals. Plain types saw more enquiry again at lower rates whilst poorest types continued to be difficult of sale with heavy withdrawals.

FANNINGS: Good liquoring Fannings met with a fair demand at lower rates often declining by Tk.5/- to Tk.8/- over last. Medium varieties eased further often by Tk/- 8/- to Tk.10/- with fair withdrawals. Plain types witnessed some enquiry at much lower rates whilst the poorest were generally neglected.

CTC DUST: 7,594 packages of teas on offer met with less demand. All good liquoring teas were easier by

Tk.12/- to Tk.15/- following a seasonal decline in quality. Others were also a lower market with heavy withdrawals especially brown fibrous and plain liquoring descriptions. Blenders lent fair interest with some interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: Quality on offer in this sale was mostly inferior to the previous as there were more end of season types available in the sale. Accordingly, the prices followed quality very closely with a large weight of poor end of season types remaining unsold. Blenders were more active with a little more interest from the Loose tea buyers. As a result, withdrawals in the leaf catalogue were less than the previous week.

Dusts were an easier market.
