## MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO.9 HELD ON JULY 20, 2020


Leaf section of sale no. 9 continued to be held at the World Trade Center. Leaf offerings consisted of 52.483 packages alongwith 6108 packages of leaf supplements. There was an improved demand for the better teas. Leaf withdrawals stood at 60% as against 61% last week.


LEAF: Well made brokens were in good demand and these prices often held firm. Mediums eased by about Tk.5/6. Plainer and the Northern teas eased further. Selective best lines sold between Tk.208.00 - Tk.246.00.

Good fannings met with a slightly improved demand but prices were lower by Tk.5/6. Mediums declined by Tk.5/8. Lower types depreciated by Tk.10.00 or more. Selective best lines sold between Tk.208.00 - Tk.260.00.

DUST: 8927 packages alongwith 886 packages of dust supplements were on offer. There was a good demand. Well made and powdery lines were often firm to dearer. Dust withdrawals stood at 28% as against 30% last week.
