# TEA MARKET REPORT - Sale 18 held on Monday 5th September, 2022

**CTC LEAF**: 43,453 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with a fairly strong demand.

BROKENS: Best liquoring varieties met with a strong demand and were mostly firm to occasionally dearer following competition. Good Brokens were well supported at around last levels whilst Mediums witnessed quite a good demand but often eased slightly. Plain varieties met with fair interest at around last levels with some withdrawals. BLF teas met with less demand at slightly easier rates but there were more withdrawals.

**FANNINGS**: Best Fannings continued to be a strong feature of the sale and were mostly firm to dearer following competition. Good and Mediums saw good demand and were generally firm. Plain Fannings witnessed a fair demand and were mostly steady. BLF teas met with less demand at slightly easier rates but there were more withdrawals.

CTC DUST: 7,739 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with a fairly good demand. Good liquoring Dusts sold well at a drop of Tk.10/- to Tk.12/-. Their Mediums were irregular around last levels. Plain and BLF Dusts were an easier market and saw more withdrawals compared to previous sale. Blenders lent good support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

**COMMENTS:** There was a larger weight of tea on offer which witnessed less competition particularly from the Loose tea buyers. Blenders continued to lend a fairly strong support at firm rates particularly for the brightest varieties. Dusts were an easier market.


