# TEA MARKET REPORT – Sale 15 held on Monday 7th August, 2023

CTC LEAF: 61,117 packages of Current Season & 462 packages of Old Season teas on offer met with a selective demand but at easier rates.

BROKENS: Except for a handful of bright liquoring Brokens which were about steady, all others declined in price particularly the Medium and plainer varieties where there were quite fair withdrawals. BLF teas met with a limited demand and again saw heavy withdrawals.

FANNINGS: A small weight of bright Fannings met with good demand but at lower rates whilst Mediums and plainer varieties were again less in demand and prices dropped by a fair margin. There were also BLF teas met with a limited several withdrawals. demand and again saw heavy withdrawals.

demand. Good liquoring Dusts were a good market and were generally firm to a little easier. Others were a fair market and sold at much easier rates with fair withdrawals. BLF Dusts met with less demand at easier rates with heavier withdrawals.

**COMMENTS:** Offerings were very heavy this week and general quality also showed some decline. Blenders were quite selective whereby only bright liquoring types sold reasonably well whilst all others suffered heavy withdrawals. Loose tea buyer were virtually absent.

In all, this sale witnessed a fair drop in price and also heavy withdrawals.

Dusts were an easier market.



Good demand continued to persist at irregular price levels for all categories of teas. The total CTC leaf teas sold this week was 1282313.71Kgs (86.32%) of the total offering of 1485589.82Kgs. The best category larger broken sold irregularly in line with quality. Good, better medium, medium & plainer teas sold firm to dearer. MEDIUM BROKEN: - Best category sold firm. Good, better medium & medium sold barely steady. Plainer teas saw a slightly upward movement by a couple of rupees especially for blacker types. SMALLER BROKEN: - Best teas sold easier at the top end, lower end saw some competition and sold dearer on quality. Others sold barely steady. FANNING: - The best category sold firm; the other sorts sold firm to dearer especially the blacker cleaner sorts. BUYING PATTERN: - The major blenders were the mainstay of the market and absorbed 51.91% of the total CTC leaf sold quantity. Regional packeteers continue to operate actively on good and better medium teas. Exporters were fairly active on the better medium, medium and blacker plainer types. Up country buyers and local traders were selective this week.
