## TEA MARKET REPORT – Sale 12 held on Monday 17th July, 2023

**CTC LEAF**: 44,501 packages of Current Season & 130 packages of Old Season teas on offer once again met with a strong demand.

**BROKENS**: All good Brokens continued to meet with a strong demand and were mostly firm to slightly dearer following competition. Other varieties witnessed improved demand at slightly dearer rates in line with quality. BLF teas met with a good demand at around last levels with a few cleaner varieties appreciating in price over last.

**FANNINGS**: Good Fannings continued to meet with a strong market and were slightly dearer following competition. Other varieties met with a little more interest and were mostly firm to slightly dearer following quality. BLF teas met with a good demand at around last levels with a few cleaner varieties appreciating in price over last. **CTC DUST**: 12,925 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with fair demand. Good liquoring Dusts had fair demand and sold Tk.5/- to Tk.8/- below last levels. Mediums were an easier market with some withdrawals. Plain and BLF had some withdrawals and sold Tk.5/- to Tk.10/- lower than last levels. Blenders were active whilst Loose tea buyers were selective.

**COMMENTS:** There was more interest for improved liquoring varieties particularly from the Blenders who continued to lend strong support. Loose tea buyers lent fair support especially for the better liquoring varieties.

Dusts were an easier market with some withdrawals.


