TEA MARKET REPORT – Sale 11 held on Monday, 21st July, 2025

CTC LEAF: 43,610 packages of tea on offer met with a strong demand.

BROKENS: Good liquoring Brokens were a strong market and were mostly dearer by upto Tk.5/- and more. Medium varieties met with more enquiry and were fully firm. Plainer sorts once again met with a fair demand and were about steady with fair withdrawals. BLF teas were again a good market and were firm to dearer.

FANNINGS: Good liquoring Fannings were a stronger market and were firm to slightly dearer. Good and Medium teas were an improved market and were mostly firm. Plainer sorts once again met with a fair demand and were about steady with fair withdrawals. BLF teas were again a good market and were firm to dearer.

DUST: 11,443 packages of tea on offer met with an improved demand. Good liquoring Dusts met with a good

competition and were fully firm to slightly dearer. Their Mediums also sold well closely following quality. Plain/BLF Dusts were barely steady with a few withdrawals. Blenders lent strong support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: There was a stronger demand this week with fair improvement in price levels. Blenders lent stronger support with Loose tea buyers participating quite actively for the brighter varieties.

It was evident throughout the sale that the buyers strictly followed quality which showed an improvement over last. Dusts were a dearer market.


