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TEA MARKET REPORT – Sale 02 held on Monday, 12th May, 2025

CTC LEAF: 22,239 packages of tea on offer once again met with a fairly strong demand.

BROKENS/FANNINGS: Well made good liquoring varieties continued to be a strong feature of the sale and witnessed more competition and these could be quoted between Tk.270/- and Tk.300/-. Below best varieties were again a good market but prices eased slightly and these sold between Tk.235/- and Tk.250/-. The remainder again met with a fair demand at slightly easier rates and prices realised between Tk.200/- and Tk.225/-. BLF teas sold fairly well and sold between Tk.160 and 205/-.

DUST: 2,796 packages of tea on offer met with a fairly strong demand. Good liquoring Dusts met with a good demand and prices were irregular closely following quality.

Others also sold at around last levels with hardly any withdrawals. Blenders lent good support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: Demand this week was a little more widespread with a few more buyers participating in the sale. The best varieties were mostly firm but all others eased a little in line with quality. Blenders continued to lend strong support with more interest from the Loose tea buyers.

All CDs were the strong feature of the sale.



COONOOR SALE 19- DATED 10TH MAY, 2025

DEMAND: - Good demand for the best category, others met with reduced demand with easier price levels and very erratic especially on the better medium and medium category teas. MARKET: - The total CTC leaf teas sold this week was 67.49 %(1180143.47kgs) of the total offering of 1748673.72Kgs. BEST:- Best liquoring teas on offer with demand continuing to persist from the local and regional buyers with prices fluctuating irregularly closely following quality. Local and Regional packagers continued to be fairly active. GOOD: - Larger and medium broken sold barely steady to easier, smaller broken eased by Rs 2 to 6 especially on the top end. Very limited fanning grade was on offer. Regional packagers, upcountry buyers were choosy and more price sensitive. BETTER MEDIUM & MEDIUM:- Better medium and medium category, all sorts saw a downward trend with prices declining between Rs 2 to 5.However, the prices continued to show no disparity between both the categories especially on the medium and smaller broken grades. Major blenders and Western India Packeteers were fairly active. Selective buying was seen from the upcountry and local buyers. Exporters were fairly active on on cleaner, blacker fanning. Larger broken continue to meet with selective buying from exporters and larger percentage of teas remain unsold. PLAINERS:- Further reduced demand with prices declining in the range of Rs 4 to 6 with bulk of teas remaining unsold in this segment. Limited buying from exporters. Major blenders were very choosy and internal buyers were selective along with the upcountry buyers but at substantially easier prices. BUYING PATTERN: - The major blenders off take was 57.05% of the total CTC leaf sold.
